


Chatteris Quirks Trail

A town walking route Total distance - 0.6 miles









Church Lane

Start this trail on the path from Church Lane through the churchyard. Head past the church towards Market Hill.

Distance 130 yards



War Memorial



Here you will see the memorial dedicated to the undying memory of the Chatteris men who gave their lives in the Great Wars. It is made of Clipsham stone and at the top of the column are carvings of St Michael and St George.

To continue on the trail turn left and use the zebra crossing to head to Station Street opposite.

Distance 70 yards



Mortuary Stone



A few paces along Station Street, where the footpath restarts, you will see a mortuary stone. This is mounted on the wall of the beige brick building just beyond the public toilets. This marks the site of the town's old mortuary.

Continue along Station Street until you pass the fire station, here you turn left onto Station Road. Distance 150 yards



Listed Buildings

As you turn onto Station Road you will see 14 Station Road opposite. This is one of Chatteris' many impressive listed buildings. Head along Station Road until you reach Park Street. Take care here to cross the road using the pedestrian island and turn right to continue along West Park Street.

Just past the local chippy you will come to Victoria Street on your left.

Distance 180 yards



Victoria Street

Turn onto Victoria Street where, a few paces along this road, on your right, you will see a brick wall merged with an old stone wall. These stones came from Chatteris Abbey. Two houses further along Victoria Street (no. 24 and 26) are also made from reclaimed Abbey stone.

Continue along Victoria Street.

Distance 230 yards



Emmanuel Church

At the end of Victoria Street turn left onto East Park Street to head back towards the town centre. Part way along this street you will see Emmanuel Church on your left. Within the church is a deep pool beneath the floor for baptism by full immersion (not available for viewing).

Distance 1000 yards



Market Hill



The route leads back to Market Hill. At the zebra crossing retrace your steps back to Church Lane to complete your trail.

Distance 280 yards
